





MOČ project public event - Cycle Around the Globe

Ljubljana, 17th August. OZARA Slovenia, National Association for Quality of Life, National Institute of Public Health, UP Andrej Marušič Institute Slovene Center for Suicide Research and Slovenian Association for Suicide Prevention are the organizers of the *Cycle around the Globe* action, which started on 10th August in the framework of MOČ project. This annual event is carried out in the framework of the World Suicide Prevention Day and is organized in Slovenia for the second time this year. The main initiator of the activity is The International Association for Suicide Prevention whereas the event in Slovenia is financed from Norwegian Financial Mechanism Programme 2009–2014.

Last year's action was very popular. The goal was exceeded by four times since 196,282 kilometres were cycled across the world while almost 40,000 kilometres were cycled in Slovenia. This year the organizers once again invite people to symbolically pedal their bikes in effort to save lives. The activity in Slovenia started on 10th August 2015 and will last until 10th September 2015, which is the official World Suicide Prevention Day.
